Our Community Giving program invites local registered community groups and non-profit organisations to apply for up to \$5,000 to support programs and initiatives that align with our focus areas and benefit the Gove Peninsula.

Applications are open February to November each year.

Guidelines

Who can apply?

Registered community groups, and non-profit organisations delivering impactful initiatives within the Gove Peninsula where Rio Tinto Gove operates.

How much can I apply for?

Each organisation can apply for a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$5,000 per calendar year. Rio Tinto may not necessarily fund the whole (or any) of the requested grant, even if they meet the funding criteria.

While we aim to support the community as much as possible, not all applications are eligible for support.

This includes:

- Organisations that have not acquitted previous Rio Tinto funding
- Individuals or for-profit companies
- Government requests, services and programs
- Political, and religious purposes and activities
- Organisations supporting communities outside of where we work
- Events or initiatives that have already occurred
- Operational and/or day-to-day cost, including but not limited to rent, utility bills and wages
- Travel
- Fundraising initiatives – including but not limited to charity dinners, quiz nights, raffle prizes and cash prizes
- Individual registration fees
- Uniform costs
- Purchase and/or supply of alcohol
- Replacement of items previously funded by Rio Tinto
- Applications received within 4 weeks of the event
- Support for annual events and initiatives will be reviewed each year, and is not guaranteed
