

Community Giving guideline and application form

Our Community Giving program invites local grass-roots organisations to apply for up to \$5,000 to support Western Australian communities where we work and live, including those neighbouring our operations and eligible regional communities.

Our Focus Areas

Thriving communities

Contribute to healthy resilient communities and wellbeing; local service and social infrastructure delivery

Creating opportunities

Build diverse local economies and regional economic development; help children and young people reach their potential through quality education and training opportunities

Caring for Country

Promote healing and cultural knowledge sharing; long term preservation and management of cultural heritage; ongoing access to healing and care of Country; rehabilitation, cultural land management and closure.

Applications are open February to November each year

Who can apply?

Local community groups, charitable or not-for-profit organisations delivering initiatives in the listed eligible communities.

Grant value

Each organisation may apply for one grant for up to \$5,000 per calendar year. Rio Tinto may choose not to fund all, or any, of the amount requested, even if the application meets the funding criteria.

- Initiatives that support improved outcomes in education and training

Caring for country

- Initiatives that support improved connection to land and culture
- Initiatives that support improved environmental outcomes

Other Regional Communities

- City of Busselton, City of Bunbury, City of Albany, City of Greater Geraldton, Shire of Broome, Shire of Derby/West Kimberley

What won't be supported?

- Organisations that have not acquitted previous Rio Tinto funding
- Individuals or for-profit companies
- State government agency requests
- Political, partisan, religious or sectarian associations
- Events and initiatives may not be supported year on year, please reach out to discuss your application if you would like any further clarification
- Initiatives delivered outside the approved Local Government Areas (LGAs) listed in the guidelines (contact your local council to confirm your LGA)
- Organisations that have a current social investment partnership agreement in place with Rio Tinto

- Initiatives that have occurred or are scheduled within four weeks
- Operational and/or day-to-day costs including but not limited to rent, utility bills, wages
- Travel away from communities where we live and work including flights and accommodation
- Fundraising initiatives and merchandise, including items such as show bags and consumables, and activities such as charity dinners, quiz nights, raffles and cash prizes
- Individual sporting clubs where there is an overarching association or league (excludes Pilbara)
- Individual registration fees and uniform costs
- Purchase and/or supply of alcohol
- Sporting season costs supported by player registration fees including but not limited to court hire, umpire fees and lighting
